

You May be Eligible for a Payment from a Class Action Settlement

The Lawsuit alleges that Nationstar Mortgage LLC (“Defendant”) recorded phone calls placed by defendants on Plaintiffs’ mobile telephones without their consent in violation of the Invasion Of Privacy Act, California Penal Code. § 630 et seq. (“IPA”). Defendant denies any wrongdoing, but has agreed to settle the Lawsuit to avoid further litigation. The settlement will create a settlement fund of \$6,500,000. Plaintiffs will request that the Court approve payments from the fund of attorneys’ fees not to exceed \$2,145,000, administration costs not to exceed \$200,000, Court Costs not to exceed \$100,000 and an incentive award to the named Plaintiffs, not to exceed, \$10,000 per Plaintiff. After these deductions, it is estimated that there will be approximately \$4,035,000 for the settlement class to be distributed pro rata.

Am I a Settlement Class Member? You may be a Settlement Class Member. You are receiving notice because Defendant’s records indicate that Defendant contacted you via telephone on your mobile phone between October 23, 2014, to May 1, 2016.

How do I get a payment? If you are a Settlement Class Member and want to receive a payment, you need to complete and submit the enclosed Claim Form, either by mailing it to Zaklit v. Nationstar Settlement Administrator P.O. Box 4349 Portland, OR 97208-4349 or submitting it online at www.CallRecordingsSettlement.com. Your Valid Claim Form must be submitted online or postmarked no later than **July 2, 2019**. After the Court grants final approval of the Settlement, you will then receive a check in the mail for an amount that shall be calculated pro rata based on the number of Valid Claim Forms that are submitted by the Settlement Class.

Who Represents Me? The Court has appointed lawyers Todd M. Friedman of the Law Offices of Todd M. Friedman, P.C. to represent the Settlement Class. These attorneys are called Class Counsel. You will not be charged for these lawyers. If you want to be represented by your own lawyer in this case, you may hire one at your expense.

What are my rights? If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you must exclude yourself from the Settlement Class by submitting an Opt-Out Form, which can be accessed at the Settlement Website address below. The deadline to exclude yourself is **July 5, 2019**. If you exclude yourself from the Settlement Class, you will not receive any money from the Settlement, but you will keep any right you have to sue Nationstar over the legal issues in the lawsuit. **If you do not exclude yourself and remain in the Settlement Class, you may object to the Settlement by July 5, 2019.** Specific instructions about how to object to, or exclude yourself from, the Settlement are available at www.CallRecordingsSettlement.com. If you file a claim or do nothing, and the Court approves the Settlement, you will be bound by all of the Court’s orders and judgments. In addition, you will release any claims against Defendant with regard to phone calls placed to you between October 23, 2014, and May 1, 2016, and will not be able to sue Defendant for any claim relating to those phone calls.

When will the Court Consider Whether to Approve the Settlement? The Court will hold a hearing on **August 19, 2019**, at United States District Court Central District of California, 350 W. 1st Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, Courtroom 8D, to consider whether to approve the Settlement and Plaintiffs’ request for attorneys’ fees and expenses and for Service Awards to the Plaintiffs. Nationstar has agreed to pay Class Counsel reasonable attorneys’ fees in an amount to be determined by the Court. Class Counsel will seek no more than 33% of the Settlement Fund, but the Court may award less than this amount. Class Counsel will file their motion for attorney’s fees no later than June 3, 2019, and a copy of the motion will be available at www.CallRecordingsSettlement.com. You may appear and speak at the hearing, but you are not required to. You may also hire an attorney at your own expense to appear or speak for you at the hearing.
